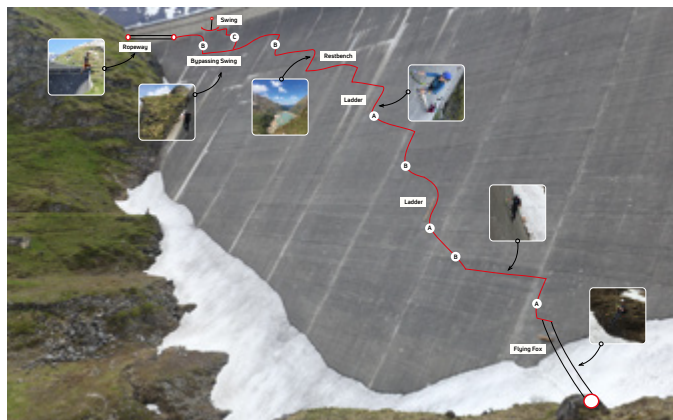

Length of climb: 240 metres • **Duration:** 20-50 minutes • **Difficulty:** A-B/C

Via ferrata MOB0107 can be used daily during the opening hours of the reservoirs.

The world's highest fixed rope route on a dam wall

The „MOB0107“ is the world's highest via ferrata right on top of a dam. The construction in a pure concrete wall was a special challenge. Especially the transport of the individual elements into the wall was difficult.

Right at the start, a zipline brings you to the entry of the MOB0107. After different climbing elements attached to the wall, a rope bridge is waiting at the exit. A small viewing platform in the wall is a good place to take a rest and enjoy the view. A little more tricky to overcome is „the swing“ at the end of the via ferrata. But there is also the possibility to bypass this one.

MOB0107 Tour - Every Wednesday and Saturday

Guided tour through the via ferrata MOB0107 with a certified mountain guide.

Meeting point and hand out of climbing equipment:

Every Wednesday and Saturday, 2 p.m. at the Basecamp MOB0107 next to the kiosk Mooserboden. Only in dry conditions!

Minimum number of participants:

4 persons, fit for sports.

Procedure:

Meeting point at base camp MOB0107, equipment hand out, instruction and training at via ferrata MOB0107.

Ascent to the Kaprun high mountain reservoirs, guided tour via ferrata MOB0107 and on the Höhenburg climbing arena until about 2 p.m.
